The FOHHAS Board of Directors may have nine to fifteen people serve on the board. Due to health reasons, one Board member has had to resign and one member has met term limit. There are two nominees for re-election and two new nominees to the Board for 2018. These candidates have been reviewed by the Executive Committee of FOHHAS and approved to be placed on this ballot. The election will be for a three year term starting January 1, 2018.

Please note: with the election of two new directors and re-election of two, upon approval, the Board will consist of 14 directors. Under our Bylaws (Section 4.2), the Board President in 2018 may make an interim appointment at a later time to fill the vacancy, with approval of two-thirds (2/3) of the Board members.
