For the past 60 years Hunt Hill has preserved hundreds of acres of pristine northern Wisconsin habitat, kept it open to the public, and has been a location to learn about and discover nature for visitors near and far.

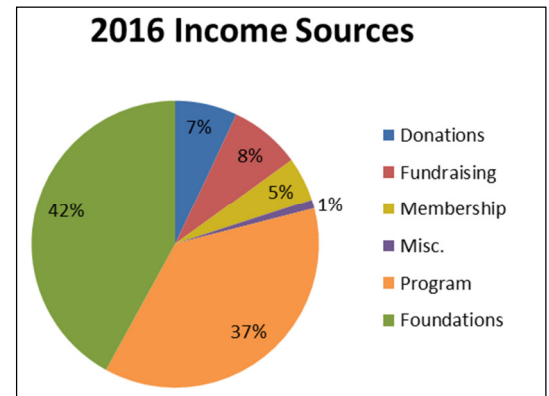
Hunt Hill's 600 acres include glacial lakes, cutover and old growth forest, prairie, marsh and bogs. This diverse habitat has made us a natural location for hands-on outdoor education.

Approximately **4,000 people a year** participate in Hunt Hill's educational programs. During a typical year, we provide on-site classroom experiences for over 1,200 students and

facilitate programming for five University of Wisconsin campuses. Our summer camp programs have been very popular, with hundreds of youth attending camps that include topics such as: Wildlife Detectives, Survival, Awesome Amphibians, Pioneer camp and more. During the summer, we have programs and events nearly every day of the week for youth and adults ranging from weeklong camps with overnight lodging and meals to day camps and hour-long lectures. These programs and events include Basket Making, Let's Go Birding, Cakes at the Lake, Prairie Fling Festival, Full Moon Snowshoe Hike, Owls of the Great Lakes, Shiitake Growing Workshop, Birds and Beer and many more.

Current funding for implementation of education programs, preservation of habitat, and maintenance of infrastructure comes primarily from program fees and foundation support. Hunt Hill does not receive government assistance. Therefore each year donations are needed to continue running Hunt Hill and keep programs affordable for children and adults.
