Youth Overnight Overview:

About Youth Overnight Camps: Hunt Hill is a nature sanctuary and learning center dedicated to fostering understanding, appreciation, and protection of the environment. The goal of our Youth Overnight Camp program is to encourage youth to get out and enjoy nature. Throughout each day, campers participate in different hands-on nature activities, games, swimming, and crafts led by a team of well-trained staff.

Weather: Campers can expect to spend the whole day of camp outside every day, rain or shine. Please set your camper up for success by ensuring they have gear appropriate for the weather such as warm clothes, rain jackets, and sun screen. If the weather becomes unsafe, we will move indoors and continue activities there. We will be sleeping in tents outside except for in unsafe weather conditions.

Safety: To ensure your child has a safe and fun time at camp, all of our staff participate in First Aid, CPR, AED, Epi-Pen, and Blood Borne Pathogens Training. Certified Lifeguards supervise all swimming and boating activities and all campers are required to pass a swimming test in order to swim in water over their heads. Our summer educators are also trained to recognize and help prevent child abuse.

Discipline: We expect our campers to follow the main rule of camp: Respect. We ask campers to show respect for people, nature, and property. To ensure the enjoyment and safety of all campers, Hunt Hill reserves the right to dismiss campers in the unlikely event there are discipline issues. Parents or guardians will be contacted by phone to arrange child pick up. No refund will be granted to those unable to complete a camp.

Meals: Hunt Hill will be providing two lunches, two mid-morning snacks, one dinner, and one breakfast for each overnight camp. Lunches and dinners will be simple kid-friendly meals that include all food groups. If you have any concerns about food, please include these in the camper's medical form.

Youth Overnight Schedule:

- Check-in is any time between 8:00 and 8:30 am on Thursday. For their safety, campers must be attended by an adult for check-in and check-out.
- Youth Overnight Camps begin at 8:30 am with a Welcome Meeting where campers learn about Hunt Hill and the expectations for their time at camp.
- Campers will be divided into small age-appropriate groups. If you would like your child to be in the same group as another child, please mark that on the registration sheet. We will try our best to accommodate any requests.
- At 4:00 on Friday, the campers put on a Parent Presentation for families to enjoy. Families are encouraged to arrive a few minutes before 4:00 to be here on time for the presentation.
- After the presentation, families must sign-out their campers before leaving camp. Campers may only leave with an adult listed on the transportation permission section of their registration form.
- Campers have the choice to stay later for After-Camp Camp on Friday, which runs from 4:00 to 5:30 pm and costs \$5/camper, if their families cannot pick them up at 4:00.

How to Register for Day Camps:

Option 1: Register and Pay Online

- Complete registration AND payment online at <https://www.cogran.io/index.html?hunthill#/home> .
- To register, please first create an account in your name. Then click “Add a participant” to add the camper’s name to the registration. If registering multiple campers, you can click “Register another participant” on the “Review Selections & Pricing” page.

Option 2: Register on Paper & Pay by Cash or Check

- 2020 Youth Day Camp Registration Form
 - Transportation permission: Be sure to include all approved adults who may pick up your camper from Hunt Hill. We will not allow campers to leave the property with anyone other than those listed on in the transportation section of the registration form.
 - Photo release: Please indicate whether you agree to let us use pictures of your camper for promotional materials. We will not use the names of campers in any promotions.
- 2020 Youth Medical Form
 - Please indicate any health concerns, medical conditions, and special accommodations on this sheet to ensure that we can keep your camper safe.
 - Informed Consent: We will provide basic first aid for any emergencies at camp. The informed consent section of the form gives our first responder permission to administer specific medications in the case of an illness or emergency.

Full Payment or Payment Plan Required:

Camp spots are reserved on first-come first-serve basis by full payment. Simply reserving a spot does not guarantee enrollment until payment is received. To ensure your camper’s spot in camp, you must send in full payment or sign up for a payment plan at least one week prior to the camp. If payment is not received within one week of the Day Camp, Hunt Hill reserves the right to fill the spot with another camper that has paid in full.

Payment Types:

- Credit Card: You make pay with credit card through online registration.
- Checks: Please make checks payable to Friends of Hunt Hill Audubon Sanctuary.
- Cash: Cash payment be delivered to the Hunt Hill office during business hours.

Refund Policy: If cancelled more than 7 days in advance, participants will receive a full refund. Cancelling 7 days to 24 hours before camp is a half refund. There is no refund if cancelled on the day of the program or if a child is unable to finish camp.

2020 YOUTH DAY CAMP TOPICS AND DATES

Week 1: June 29 - July 3

June 29: Frogs & Salamanders Join Hunt Hill to search the woods and the water for our amphibian friends! Spot a blue-spotted salamander, catch a leopard frog, and net a tadpole all at one camp.



June 30: Cute Animals June is the perfect time to find cute baby animals at Hunt Hill! Visit the baby birds in their nests, catch tadpoles swimming in the lake, and spot baby bunnies out in the yard!

July 1: Space Camp Spend the day as an astronaut exploring the planets in our solar system! You will get to launch a model rocket, investigate space rocks, and feel what it's like to walk on another planet.



July 2: Splash! Need a cool down on a hot summer day? Enjoy a day sliding on a slip and slide, snorkeling in the lake, and tossing wet sponges!

July 3: Lost in the Woods What would you do if you got lost in the woods? At this camp, you will learn how to find your way around and the skills to help you stay safe while out enjoying nature!

Week 3: July 13-17

July 13: Mad Scientists Are you a mad scientist? Try out some experiments that are colorful, bubbly, slimey, and sticky!



July 14: Digging Dinos Spend the day as a paleontologist digging up dinosaur bones, finding fossils, and playing dinosaur-related games.

July 15: Survival! Do you have the skills to survive? Learn how to build a shelter, find clean water, identify wild edibles, and light a one-match fire!

July 16: Wet & Wild Get wild! Run through the sprinkler, splash into the lake and slip and slide on the lawn!

July 17: Nature Art Inspiration is everywhere! In this camp, you'll get to make art out of natural materials like leaves, sticks, rocks, seeds, and sand!



Week 5: August 10-14

August 10: STEM Day Enjoy nature STEM challenges such as building the silliest spider web, best beaver dam, and the biggest bird's nest!



August 11: Wildlife Detectives Spot some clues around camp and learn how to track down an animal. If you're lucky, you might even solve a Hunt Hill mystery!

August 12: Feathered Friends Borrow some of Hunt Hill's binoculars to spot some birds! By the end of the day, you will know some common bird songs and even be able to identify a nest!

August 13: Pirate Camp Arg! There's a legend that pirates buried some treasure here at Hunt Hill! Use your skills to decipher the nature clues to track down the treasure!



August 14: Someday! We said we'd do it "someday." Today is Someday! We will do all the wacky, silly ideas that we had over the summer. Who knows... maybe we'll even break out the bouncy castle!

Week 2: July 6 -10

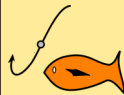
July 6: Yuck! At this camp, you will learn about the things that make us say "Yuck!" Catch bugs, play with slime, and identify different animal scat!

August 4: Storm Chasers Do some wacky weather experiments including capturing a cloud in a cup, creating a tornado in a bottle, and putting a rainbow on a wall!

August 6-7: Survival Campout Test out your survival skills at the Survival Campout! Campers will build their own fire for cooking meals and put up their own tents out in the woods.
