



School Environmental Educator Job Description (Seasonal)

Hunt Hill Nature Center, Inc. is a non-profit organization, open to all, dedicated to fostering understanding, appreciation, and protection of the environment. Hunt Hill protects nearly 600 acres of Wisconsin lands and waters and provides hands-on outdoor education to youth, adults, and the public.

Summary: Environmental Educators will work closely with the Group Coordinator to implement effective environmental education programs at our facility, primarily for school youth in pre-kindergarten through grade 8. Environmental educators teach and lead a variety of established nature programs to visiting school groups. Training in environmental education fundamentals, specific program curriculum, emergency procedures, and working with youth will be provided.

Dates and hours of employment: School Educators sign up for the dates they want to work out of the available field trip dates. The majority of field trip opportunities occur during the spring (April-June) and fall (September-October) seasons. A typical day begins at 8:30 am and ends by 3:00 pm.

Specific Duties Include:

- Prepare for programs by becoming comfortable with the provided lesson plans, materials, and settings.
- Lead fun and hands-on, outdoor-based environmental education programs to visiting school groups, using the developed curriculum, engagingly and enthusiastically.
- Assist in logistics for programs, including program set-up and clean-up.
- Ensure the safety of students during programs.

Qualifications:

- Minimum of 18 years of age.
- Possess an interest in nature, the outdoors, and working with youth.
- Enthusiastic, dependable, trustworthy.
- Demonstrated ability to work with minimal supervision.
- Experience teaching is preferred.

Compensation:

- \$90/day (more than three student contact hours)
- \$45/half-day (three or fewer student contact hours)
- Opportunity to attend Red Cross First Aid, CPR, AED course at no charge, if requested.
