What to Look For:

- Golden cap on head & on wing
- Silvery gray body

Where & When to Find Me

Year-round near the bird-feeders in main camp

What to Look For:

- fully red head, white breast
- black wings with white bands

Where & When to Find Me

Summer on the lakes, Bear Trail & Heron Point

What to Look For:

- black with white spots
- red eye

Where & When to Find Me

Osprey platform along Old Hwy Trail



What to Look For:

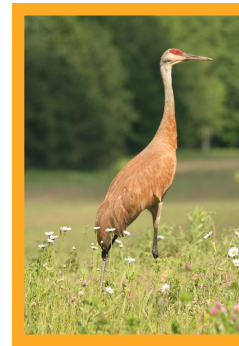
- white body & dark brown wings
- hooked beak & talons for fishing

Where & When to Find Me

Spring, Summer & Fall in the Prairie or Crane Trail



What to Look For:

- four-foot tall with long legs
- brown with red cap on head

Piranga olivacea

Where & When to Find Me

Summer in the forest, Bear Trail & Red Oak Trail



What to Look For:

- bright red body
- black wings & tail
